The Library is equipped with a wide selection of books and reading materials, stateof-the-art IT facilities, a high-tech 6D theater and a gym. If you wish to relax and read whilst simultaneously enjoying the serene and breathtaking panoramic view, this Library is the place for you.

Taman Botani Negara Shah Alam

Taman Botani Negara, Shah Alam is just the place if you want to get away from the madding crowd and the hustle and bustle of city life. This park is a 1,295hectare tropical rain forest and agriculture park where you can get up close and personal with the flora and fauna, the lush tropical rain forest, the majestic hills and various other attractions. You can cycle or walk at a leisurely pace and take time to smell the flowers.

Blue Mosque

The Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Mosque, also known as the Blue Mosque, is one of the most stunning architectural marvels that dot the Shah Alam landscape. This mosque is not only the largest in Malaysia, but also the second largest in Southeast Asia after the Istiqlal Mosque in Jakarta, Indonesia. It is well-known as the Blue Mosque due to its massive silver-blue dome on its central building, surrounded by four tower-like minarets. The mosque also overlooks the Garden of Islamic Arts, a 14-hectare park, housing nine galleries of rich Islamic art, sculptures, literature and calligraphy.

Shah Alam Lake Gardens

The Shah Alam Lake Gardens is a 43-hectare beautifully landscaped garden with three man-made lakes. Here, you can rent kayaks to row and enjoy a scenic trip down the lake. There is also a Wet World water theme park with playgrounds and seafood restaurants. During weekends and public holidays, the Lake Garden is a popular retreat for a day out with family and friends. You can also visit the Shah Alam Gallery or the Laman Budaya Culture Centre nearby.

Ardence Labs Setia Alam

Not quite different from Seoul's iconic Common Ground pastel blue container café, Shah Alam can boast of its very own with Ardence Labs Setia Alam. It is a 27-acre neighbourhood development which is located at the heart of Eco Ardence, its flagship town. Some of the tenants include coffee houses like Cocomomo; tea brands like TeaLive; Jaya Grocer and more. It is easy to spend the whole day exploring the area. Besides the iconic pastel blue container, there are also red and black

Setia Alam Night Market

Arguably the nation's longest night market, the Setia Alam night market comprises three parallel rows of stalls, of more than a kilometre long in the Setia Alam residential estate in Shah Alam. A variety of food, snacks, drinks, clothing/apparels, toys, electronic gadgets and souvenirs can be bought at bargain prices.

Then, just head to Aviax, a cockpit flight simulator, where you can experience flying without a pilot's license and from the comfort of your seat on the ground.
